



Petition Against Cobra-Style Lights in Craneridge

To the Town of Concord Board of Directors:

We, the undersigned Residents of the Craneridge Association, strongly oppose the installation of Cobra-style lights in our community. While we appreciate the Town Board's efforts to improve our neighborhood's lighting, we believe cobra-style lights are an unsuitable choice for several reasons:

- **Aesthetics:** These lights are out of place in our unique neighborhood setting, clash with the architectural character of our neighborhood and detract from its overall charm.
- **Light Pollution:** Cobra-style lights can cast excessive glare and light pollution, disrupting the natural night sky and impacting wildlife.
- **Alternatives:** We believe there may be other cost-effective lighting options that offer similar benefits without the negative aesthetic and environmental impacts, such as the demonstration LED lights that have been installed near our meadow.
